## Project Highlight: 900-Acres

The Eisenhower Realty Group 900-acre project on Safford Road and County Road 579 was the first project to be monitored by the Wimauma Community Plan Activation Task Force (WCPAT). In monitoring this 1,800 homes project, the WCDC, the WCPAT, and concerned residents met with the Eisenhower Realty Group through this year. The goal was to share community concerns with the developer and negotiate required community benefits for the benefits of all Wimauma residents.

Good News! The developer increased its community benefits due to our advocacy efforts. This includes 180 homes for affordable housing, open parks and trails, a new schools, and faith centers to name a few.

The WCDC will continue to monitor this project throughout the project development cycle.

A Wimauma native-born resident called the WCDC offices.
